A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT SUPPORTING PROPOSITION 217

WHEREAS, a measure known as Proposition 217 will go before California voters on the November 1996 ballot; and

WHEREAS, under Proposition 217, these taxes were for non-enterprise activities; police, sheriffs, parks, libraries, emergency medical services and child protection, and would be received for that entity only (security); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of The Rancho Murieta Community Services District supports Proposition 217 as it relates to restoring stability to city, county and special district services, and will help relieve the burden on local taxpayers.
