#### IMPORTANT TAX INFORMATION

With the approval of Measure J & K in 1998, the Security and Drainage charges on your CSD bill are Special Taxes. Consequently, the amount a **property owner** pays for these charges may be deductible. If you itemize your deductions on IRS Form 1040, Schedule A, you may deduct the aggregate sum paid for the Security and Drainage Taxes during 2017.

In order to determine the amount that is deductible, use the **WORKSHEET** available on the District's website at <a href="https://www.rmcsd.com">www.rmcsd.com</a> or the form included in your billing statement. This information should assist you and/or your tax preparer in preparing your 2017 tax return.

# KEEP DRAINAGE INLETS CLEAR

It is the responsibility of the residents and homeowner associations to keep the drainage inlets cleared of yard waste and debris. If the inlets in the curbing are clogged with leaves and branches, water may back up in low-lying areas and can create flooding and inconvenience.

If you take care of your own lawn and garden maintenance or have a maintenance service, it is important to see that clogging does not occur. Heavy downpours in a short period of time can overwhelm culverts. Your cooperation is appreciated.

## SECURITY REMINDERS

When the school bus stops and the flashing red lights come on, vehicles must stop and wait behind the bus or facing the bus if the roadway is not divided. Bus drivers are very cautious in seeing that their riders are out of harm's way before moving on. A few extra seconds to be cautious is time well spent!

# **KEEP YOUR WASTEWATER/SEWER LINES OPEN**

Although we flush human waste down the toilet it does not mean sewers are waste disposal units. Sewers are not designed to cope with modern disposable products, and as a result these items can cause blockages. The drains connecting your home to the main sewer are only big enough to carry water, toilet paper, and human waste. They are often no wider than four inches. Around 75 percent of blockages involve disposable items. Avoid sewer line blockages which can be a drain on your finances due to expensive plumbing repairs.
