ORDINANCE NO. 85-8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF THE DISTRICT CODE
RELATING TO PERSONNEL RULES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Rancho Murieta Community Services District as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 4.01 of Chapter 5 of the District Code is hereby amended to read:

4.01 <u>Personnel Organization</u>. The District is organized into several departments. Each department includes one or more job classifications. Each classification has one or more authorized positions.

SECTION TWO: Section 4.02 of Chapter 5 of the District Code is hereby amended to read:

4.02 <u>Salary Ranges</u>. The District has adopted certain salary ranges for District employees. These ranges may be changed from time to time by District action.

SECTION THREE: Section 4.05 of Chapter 5 of the District Code is hereby amended to read:

4.05 Salary Organization. Each authorized position is in one salary range. Each salary range includes salary steps.

SECTION FOUR: Section 4.13(a) of Chapter 5 of the District Code is hereby amended to read:

## 4.13 Salary Plan Administration.

(a) The District has a salary schedule which denotes the steps in the pay ranges of the District salary plan.

## SECTION FIVE:

To the extent the terms and conditions of this Ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions of any prior District ordinances, resolutions, rules, or regulations, the terms of this Ordinance shall prevail with respect to the terms and provisions thereof and such inconsistent or conflicting terms and provisions of prior ordinances, resolutions, rules, and regulations are hereby repealed.

## SECTION SIX:

If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, no other provision of this Ordinance shall be affected thereby.

## SECTION SEVEN:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after adoption and shall be published not less than once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the District within thirty (30) days after adoption.
