WHEREAS, the District has considered the establishment of a Deferred Compensation Plan to be made available to all eligible District employees, elected officials, and independent contractors pursuant to Federal legislation permitting such Plans; and

WHEREAS, certain substantial tax benefits could accrue to employees, elected officials, and independent contractors participating in said Deferred Compensation Plans; and

WHEREAS, such benefits will act as incentives to District employees to voluntarily set aside and invest portions of their current income to meet their future financial requirements and supplement their District retirement and Social Security (if applicable), at no cost to the District; and

WHEREAS, The U.S. Conference of Mayors has established a master prototype deferred compensation program for cities and political subdivisions permitting its member cities and their employees to enjoy the advantages of this program;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

The Board of Directors hereby adopts the U.S. Conference of Mayors Deferred Compensation Program and its attendant investment



options and hereby establishes the Rancho Murieta Community Services District Deferred Compensation Plan for the voluntary participation of all eligible District employees, officials and independent contractors.

The District Manager is hereby authorized to execute for the District, individual participation agreements with each said employee requesting same, and to act as the "Administrator" of the Plan representing the District, and to execute such agreements and contracts as are necessary to implement the It is implicitly understood that other than the incidental expenses of collecting and disbursing the employee's deferrals and other minor administrative matters, that there is to be no cost or contribution by the District to the Program.
