Subject: Security Department Update – September 2026

Operations Update

The Security Department continues to prioritize staffing stability, operational readiness, and proactive community engagement. Key updates are as follows:

- All full-time Security Department positions are currently filled.
 - Current staffing levels:
 - 8 Full-Time Gate Officers
 - 4 Part-Time Gate Officers
 - 2 Full-Time Patrol Officers
 - 14 Total Employees (including 2 probationary employees)
 - ABDI Gate Entry System Upgrade was approved at prior board meeting; contracts have been received for General Manager to approve and sign.
 - Scheduling is now done through Paychex, employees now have 3 different areas where they can view their schedule (posted at gates, email copy and Paychex).
 - Uniform polos have been provided to all Security Staff in accordance with Union MOU (Total Cost: \$1,984.22) Gate Officers received 4 polos and Patrol Officers received 3 polos. Staff was also reminded of uniform standards while on duty.
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Rancho Murieta Association (RMA) Coordination

The Security Department continues to work closely with Rancho Murieta Association (RMA) leadership to strengthen rule enforcement, improve compliance efforts, and enhance overall community safety. Current collaborative efforts include:

- Ongoing enforcement of non-architectural RMA rules in coordination with RMA Compliance (see Violation Summary Report). Continued attendance and active participation in RMA Compliance Committee meetings to improve communication and coordination between agencies.

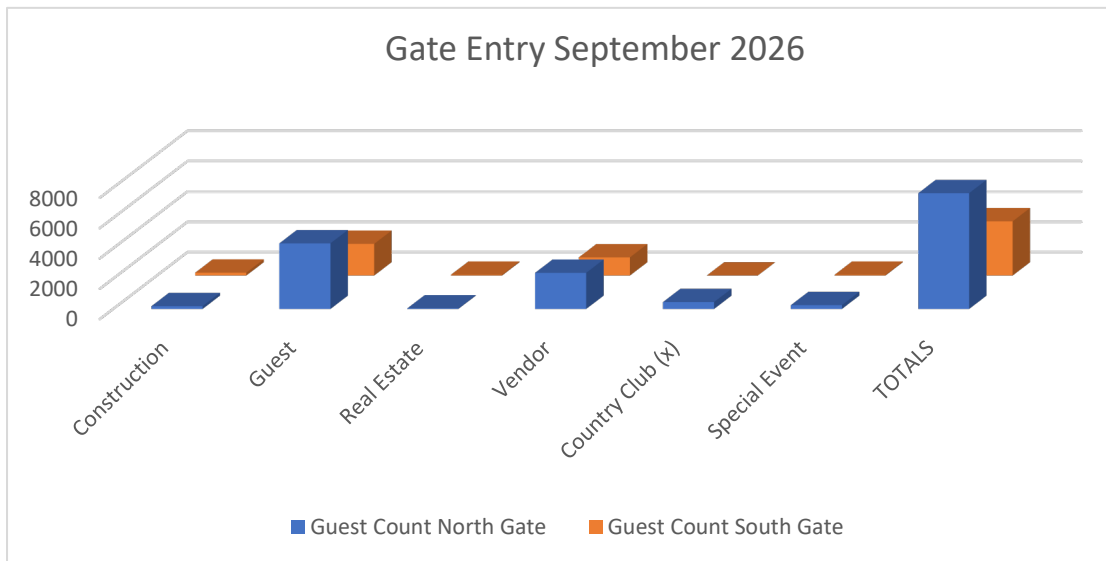

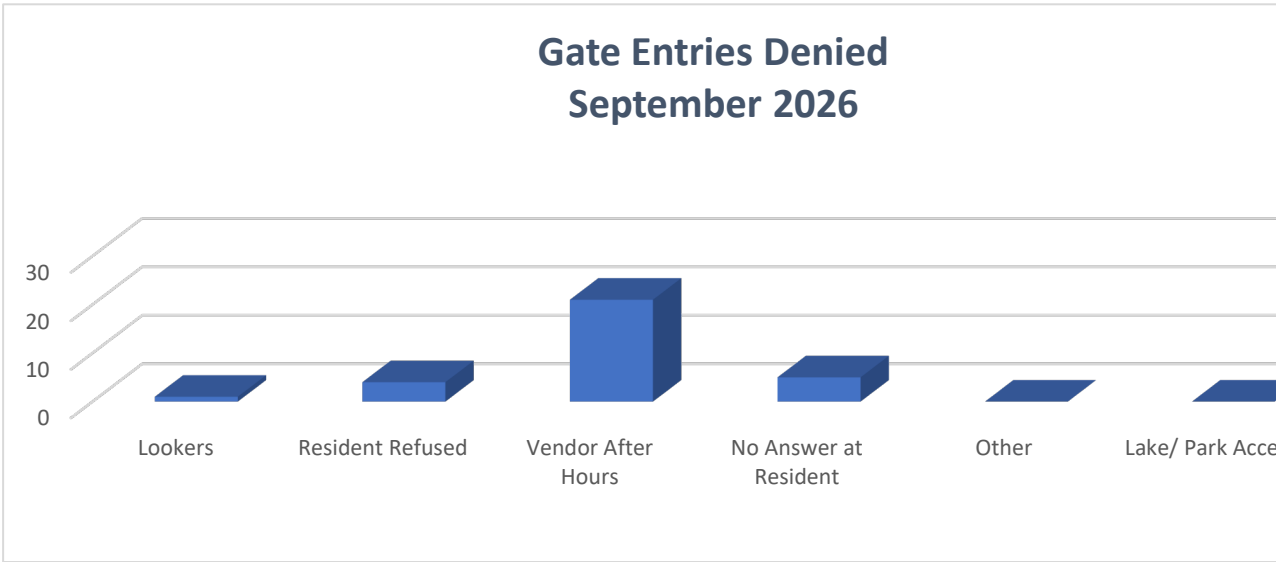

September 2026 Incidents of Note

September 16, 2026 – 1:00 AM | Stolen Vehicle

Location: Murieta Inn and Spa

At approximately 8:00 AM on September 16, 2026, the Murieta Inn and Spa manager contacted RMCSd Security Dispatch to report the theft of a red, four-seat golf cart from the hotel parking lot. The golf cart was believed to have been stolen at approximately 1:00 AM that morning.

Security Supervisor Arino reviewed available surveillance camera footage covering Murieta Drive and the intersection of Murieta Drive and Jackson Road in an attempt to identify the golf cart, possible suspects, or other activity associated with the reported theft.

A review of the available footage did not reveal the golf cart, any identifiable suspects, or other activity that could be directly associated with the reported theft.
