## ORDINANCE NO. 90-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE DISTRICT CODE RELATING TO
WATER SERVICE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Rancho Murieta Community Services District, Rancho Murieta, Sacramento County California, as follows:

## SECTION ONE:

Section 4.04 <u>Size or Service Connection and Meters</u> and 4.18 <u>Inspection</u>, are modified, and Section 7.11 <u>Inspection Fees</u>, is added, as follows:

# 4.04 Size or Service Connection and Meters.

- (a) Remain the same.
- (b) The size of the meter serving a premise shall be approved by the District in advance of service. The standard size water meter serving a mobile village lot and townhouse lot shall be 5/8 inch x 3/4 inch meter, for all other residential lots, it shall be a 3/4 inch or 1 inch meter.

#### 4.18 <u>Inspection of Construction.</u>

- (a) The District shall have the right to inspect all work on the water distribution system during and subsequent to its construction. When construction is completed, the work must be inspected and approved in writing by the District before the newly constructed facilities may be connected to the District's distribution system. No construction shall be covered at any time unless it has been inspected and approved by the District. No facilities shall be connected to the District's system unless the District has performed tests indicating the new construction is satisfactory and the facilities have been cleaned of all debris accumulated from construction operations.
- (b) The applicant shall give the District at least forty-eight hours advance notice, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays excluded, of when it wishes the District to perform an inspection. If work is inspected and deemed inadequate, the District shall so notify the applicant in writing and identify the deficiencies in the project.

#### 7.11 Inspection Fees.

(a) A fee based upon costs, labor and parts shall be

paid to the District for issuing a permit and inspecting each water line. The amount of this fee shall be determined from time to time by the Manager and/or Board of Directors of the District.

(b) Inspection charges shall be paid prior to connection to the District's distribution system.

# SECTION TWO:

To the extent the terms and conditions of this Ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions of any prior District ordinances, resolutions, rules, or regulations, the terms of this Ordinance shall prevail with respect to the terms and provisions thereof, and such inconsistent or conflicting terms and provisions of prior ordinances, resolutions, rules, and regulations are hereby repealed.

#### SECTION THREE:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect sixty (60) days after adoption and shall be published not less than once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the District within ten (10) days after adoption.

### SECTION FOUR:

The establishment, modification, structuring, restructuring and approval of the fees, rates, tolls, or other charges as set forth herein are for the purposes of continuing to meet the District's costs for operation and maintenance, supplies and equipment, financial reserves, and capital replacement needs, and are necessary to maintain service within the District's existing service area.
