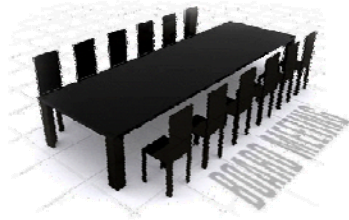

REMINDER: During the rainy season, turn off your sprinklers and irrigation system or install a rain sensor to automatically shut off your irrigation system and eliminate unnecessary watering.



LEAF RAKING TIME

With summer ending, the leaves are changing colors and dropping from the trees. Raked leaves can fill the green waste container quickly. If you have more leaves and green waste than your container can handle, place the leaves in a plastic bag, securely fasten the bag and place it alongside your gray container for regular pickup.



California Waste Recovery Systems (Cal-Waste) provides this service annually from December 1st to March 31st, at no additional cost.

Leaves that get in the storm drain inlets below street level can clog the drain pipes which could cause flooding. The District maintains these pipes, but you can help by keeping the leaves out of the street.

DISTRICT REBATES

Here are the rebates available through the end of the 2014.

- Toilet Rebate: You can receive a rebate of up to \$100 when you purchase and install a water efficient toilet.
- Clothes Washer: You can receive a rebate of up to \$125 when you purchase a high-efficiency clothes washer. The overall efficiency rating of the clothes washer will determine the amount of the rebate.
- Water Pressure Reducing Valve: You can receive a rebate of up to \$100 when you purchase and install a water pressure reducing valve.
- Water Heater Recirculating Pump: You can receive a rebate of up to \$100 when you purchase and install a water heater recirculating pump.
- Weather Based Sprinkler Controller: You can receive a rebate of up to \$100 when you purchase and install a weather based sprinkler controller.
