ORDINANCE NO. 87-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE RANCHO MURIETA

COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

AMENDING CHAPTER 21 OF THE DISTRICT CODE,

ESTABLISHING POLICIES AND CHARGES AND REGULATING
THE PROVISION OF SECURITY SERVICE BY THE DISTRICT

Be it ordained by the Board of Directors of the Rancho Murieta Community Services District, Rancho Murieta, Sacramento County, California, as follows:

## SECTION 1:

Section 5.07 is added to Chapter 21 of the District Code as follows:

Section 5.07. The District shall collect from all applicants for security service, a community facilities fee to ensure the continued availability of security related equipment through periodic expansion and replacement of security equipment. The community facilities fee shall be paid as specified in the Community Facilities Fee Code.

## SECTION 2:

The Board hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance or any sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared to be unconstitutional.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of the Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, such decision does not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Chapter or the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances.

## SECTION 3:

To the extent the terms and conditions of this Ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions of any prior District ordinances, resolutions, rules, or regulations, the terms of this Ordinance shall prevail with respect to the terms and provisions thereof and such inconsistent or conflicting terms and provisions of prior ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations are hereby repealed.

## SECTION 4:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after adoption and shall be published not less than once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the District within ten days after adoption.
