ORDINANCE NO. 91-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT, AMENDING CHAPTER 21, TO THE DISTRICT CODE, CONCERNING SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT, Rancho Murieta, Sacramento County, California, as follows:

SECTION ONE:

Section 3.01 (a) is hereby amended to Chapter 21 of the District Code as follows:

(a) Staffing the security gates located at the entrance to Rancho Murieta, 365 days a year;

Sections b-f remain the same.

SECTION TWO:

To the extent and terms the provisions of this ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions of any prior District ordinances, resolutions, rules, or regulations, the terms of this ordinances shall prevail and such inconsistent or conflicting terms and provisions or prior ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE:

If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, no other provision of this ordinance shall be affected thereby.

SECTION FOUR:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after adoption and shall be published not less then once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the District within ten days after adoption.
