BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Rancho Murieta Community Services District agrees to reimburse the Registrar of Voters for actual costs accrued for each election, such costs to be calculated by proration methods set forth in the County's current Election Cost Allocation Procedures on the basis of the amount of services provided to the Rancho Murieta Community Services District.
