

ORDINANCE NO. 89-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT  
AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE DISTRICT CODE RELATING TO WATER  
AND CHAPTER 15 OF THE DISTRICT CODE RELATING TO SEWER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Rancho Murieta  
Community Services District, Rancho Murieta, Sacramento County  
California, as follows:

SECTION ONE:

Chapter 14, Section 7.00 Rates and Charges is amended as  
follows:

Section 7.05 Rates for Metered Service.

(a) General metered service shall be as follows:

BI-MONTHLY BILLING

Basic service charge	\$16.20
[Includes 500 cf]	
Volumetric rate:	\$00.70/100 cf
[Excess of 500 cf]	

SURCHARGE for multiple units above one: \$8.00 per unit.

(b) Metered service to residential lots at Murieta Village  
shall be as follows:

BI-MONTHLY BILLING

Basic service charge	\$12.30
[Includes 500 cf]	
Volumetric rate:	\$00.70/100 cf
[Excess of 500 cf]	

Chapter 15, Section 7.00 Rates and Charges, and Collection  
Procedures is amended as follows:

Section 7.03 Rates and Charges for Service. The monthly  
service charge for each premises receiving sewer service from the  
District shall be:

Residential or other premises, each unit	\$ 15.66 per month
Murieta Village, per unit	\$ 12.16 per month
Training Center	\$160.00 per month
Equestrian Center	\$ 54.66 per month

SECTION TWO:

To the extent the terms and provisions of this Ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions of any prior District ordinances, resolutions, rules, or regulations, the terms of this Ordinance shall prevail with respect to the subject matter hereof and such inconsistent or conflicting terms and provisions of prior ordinances, resolutions, rules, and regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE:


The establishment, modification, structuring, restructuring and approval of the fees, rates and charges heretofore set forth in SECTION ONE hereof, are for the purposes of continuing to provide funds to meet the District's costs of operation and maintenance, supply and equipment, financial reserve, debt service and capital replacement needs, and are necessary to maintain and improve within the District's existing service boundaries.

SECTION FOUR:


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after adoption and shall be published within ten days of adoption in a newspaper of general circulation published within the District.
