RESOLUTION AMENDING FIXED EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTION FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL CARE ACT

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Rancho Murieta Community Services District has heretofore adopted Resolution No. 84-9 establishing a Fixed Employer's Contribution for Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Rancho Murieta Community Services District desires to amend the Employer's Contribution amount for said Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of Rancho Murieta Community Services District resolves that the section of Resolution 84-9, amended by Resolution 84-11, describing the Employer's Contribution, shall be amended to read as follows:

That the employer's contribution for each employee or annuitant shall be the amount necessary to pay the full cost of his enrollment, including the enrollment of his family members, in a health benefits plan or plans up to a maximum of \$134.00 with respect to employees or annuitants enrolled for self alone, \$253.00 for an employee or annuitant enrolled for self and one family member, and \$338.00 for an employee or annuitant enrolled for self and two or more family members plus administrative fees and Contingency Reserve Fund assessments. This change is effective August 1, 1988.



Subject: Employer Contributions - Health Care

In 1984 the Board adopted a Resolution to provide Public Employees Medical and Hospital Care benefits for CSD employees. At that time, employer contribution amounts were established for single, two-party, and three or more family members. Health care costs have risen dramatically during the last several months, and PERS has made several changes in their providers in an effort to control those costs. We have not increased the amount of contributions since 1984.

We would like to recommend a change in the employer contributions to accommodate the increases. The increase is approximately 8%.

Single	\$115.00	\$134.00
Two-party	225.00	253.00
Three or more	270.00	338.00

The effective date of this change is recommended to be August 1, 1988.
