

ORDINANCE NO. 85-9

AN ORDINANCE
OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE DISTRICT CODE
RELATING TO WATER SERVICE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Rancho Murieta Community Services District, Rancho Murieta, Sacramento County, California, as follows:

SECTION ONE:

The Water Code, Chapter 14 of the District Code, is amended in part as follows:

SECTION 7.04: Capital Improvement Connection Fee.

(b) For multiple dwellings, commercial, and/or industrial facilities, CICF shall be .75 times the number of dwelling units, commercial, and/or industrial facilities, times the fee for a 5/8" x 3/4" meter.

(c) Murieta Village: Each applicant for water service to residential lots at Murieta Village shall pay a CICF in the amount of Four Hundred Forty-seven Dollars (\$447.00) per village residential lot.

SECTION TWO:

To the extent the terms and provisions of this Ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions of any prior District ordinances, resolutions, rules, or regulations, the terms of this Ordinance shall prevail with respect to the subject matter hereof and such inconsistent or conflicting terms and provisions of prior ordinances, resolutions, rules, and regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE:

The establishment, modification, structuring, restructuring and approval of the fees, rates and charges heretofore set forth in SECTION ONE hereof, are for the purposes of continuing to provide funds to meet the District's costs of operation and maintenance, supply and equipment, financial reserve, debt service and capital replacement needs, and are necessary to maintain and improve service within the District's existing service boundaries.

SECTION FOUR:


This Ordinance shall be published within ten (10) days of adoption in a newspaper of general circulation published within the District. This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
