# ORDINANCE NO. 87-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY
SERVICES DISTRICT, AMENDING CHAPTER 8 OF THE DISTRICT
CODE RELATING TO COMMUNITY FACILITIES FEES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of the Rancho Murieta Community Services District, Rancho Murieta, Sacramento County, California as follows:

#### SECTION ONE:

Section 3.03 of the Community Facilities Fee Code, Chapter 8 of the District Code, is amended as follows:

## SECTION 3.00 Fees

### 3.03 Amount of Community Facilities Fees.

d) Community facilities fee per premise equipped with private fire protection systems connected to the Districts distribution system, for each 5/8 x 3/4 inch, 3/4 inch or 1 inch size service:

The sum of

\$ 750.00

### SECTION TWO:

To the extent the terms and conditions of this Ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and provisions of any prior District ordinances, resolutions, rules, or regulations, the terms of this Ordinance shall prevail with respect to the terms and provisions thereof and such inconsistent or conflicting terms and provisions of prior ordinances, resolutions, rules, and regulations are hereby repealed.

#### SECTION THREE:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after adoption and shall be published not less than once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the District within ten (10) days after adoption.

#### SECTION FOUR:

The establishment, modification, structuring, restructuring and approval of the fees, rates, tools, or other charges as set forth herein are for the purposes of continuing to meet the District's costs for operation and maintenance, supplies and equipment, financial reserves, and capital replacement needs, and are necessary to maintain ser-

vice within the District's existing service area.
