## **COMMUNITY CRIME MAP**

We now have a link to LexisNexis – Community Crime Map on our website for you to check for crime activity in your area.

#### How does it work?

Law enforcement agencies keep detailed records about each incident that occurs in their jurisdictions. When an incident occurs, the officer that responded to the incident writes a detailed report with information about the event including the location, people involved, related vehicles and other useful information. This information is stored in large, secure databases within each law enforcement agency. Between departments, these databases can vary in structure and complexity, and even the data itself can follow different standards to describe the event. This can make it difficult for two neighboring cities to share crime data and benefit from being able to analyze events and offenders that cross city boundaries. LexisNexis's Community Crime Map takes this data, cleans it to protect victim privacy, and displays it to the public so citizens can be aware of the events that occur in their area and take action to stay safe.

## **LEAF RAKING TIME**

When summer ends, leaves change colors and drop from the trees. Raked leaves can fill the green waste containers pretty quickly. If you have more leaves and green waste



than your container can handle, place the leaves in a plastic bag which is securely fastened and place alongside your gray container for regular pickup between December 1 and March 31. This additional service is provided by Cal-Waste for residents of Rancho Murieta at no additional cost.

Leaves, which get into the storm drain inlets below street level, can clog the drain pipes and result in flooding. The District maintains these pipes, but you can help by keeping the leaves out of the streets.
