RESOLUTION NO. 84-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RANCHO MURIETA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT CALLING A DISTRICT ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE DISTRICT SHOULD ADOPT ADDITIONAL POWERS AND REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION WITH THE JUNE 5, 1984, ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the Rancho Murieta Community Services
District has been duly organized to provide the following
services: police protection and security services; road
construction and maintenance; landscaping maintenance;
drainage construction and maintenance; public recreation;
and street lighting, as set forth in Resolution No. 82-146
and approved by the voters at an election held on June 8,
1982; and

WHEREAS, the Rancho Murieta Community Services

District has been authorized to exercise additional powers

for the provision of water service, sewer service and storm

drainage service, as set forth in Resolution No. LAFCO 810,

passed and adopted on November 3, 1982; and approved by the

voters at an election held on March 8, 1983; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Rancho
Murieta Community Services District has determined, upon
careful consideration and public hearing, that it is feasible,
economically sound, and in the public interest, for the
District to exercise the following additional powers:



fire protection service; ambulance service; collection or disposal of garbage or refuse matters; mosquito abatement; library service; construction and improvement of bridges, culverts, curbs, gutters, drains and works incidental to road construction and maintenance; conversion of existing overhead electric and communication facilities to underground locations; provision and maintenance of public airports and landing places for aerial traffic; and transportation services, provided that the voters of the District, by majority vote cast, approve these additional powers as additional purposes of the District; and

WHEREAS, Rancho Murieta Community Services District is authorized to prescribe and collect rates and charges for authorized purposes, including the proposed additional purposes described herein, as such additional purposes or approved by the voters; and

WHEREAS, on February 1, 1984, the Sacramento County
Local Agency Formation Commission adopted Resolution LAFC
848, which approved the District's use of the additional
powers and provision of services identified herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Rancho Murieta Community Services District as follows:

1. A special district election is hereby called pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 61601

and Election Code Sections 23500 et seq., to be held within the boundaries of the Rancho Murieta Community Services

District on Tuesday, June 5, 1984, at which election there shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the District the following proposition:

Proposition: "Shall the Rancho Murieta Community
Services District include providing fire protection
service; ambulance service; garbage or refuse
collection or disposal; mosquito abatement;
library service; construction and improvement of
bridges, culverts, curbs, gutters, drains, and
works incidental to road construction and maintenance;
conversion of existing overhead and electric
communication facilities to underground locations;
public airports and landing places for aerial
traffic; and transportation service as additional
District purposes for which all the powers of a
district may be exercised as provided in the
Community Services District law?"

- 2. Pursuant to Elections Code Sections 23300 et seq., the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors is hereby requested to order consolidation of the above special election with any other election to be held on the same date of June 5, 1984.
- 3. Pursuant to Elections Code Section 22003, the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors is hereby requested

to authorize and permit the Registrar of Voters of Sacramento County to render all such services and to make all such arrangements as may be necessary to conduct this special District election, in conformity with the applicable provisions of the California Elections Code, and to canvass the returns of the special election and certify the results of the canvass to this Board, and the District agrees to reimburse the Registrar of Voters for actual costs incurred for the election, such cost to be calculated by proration method or other appropriate method as set forth in the County's current election cost allocation procedures on the basis of the amount of services provided to the Rancho Murieta Community Services District.

- 4. All persons who reside within the boundaries of Rancho Murieta Community Services District and who are qualified to vote in general district elections within this District upon the date of the special election herein provided shall be qualified to vote on the proposition to be submitted at the special district election.
- 5. The Secretary of the Board of Directors is hereby directed to immediately file certified copies of this resolution with the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors and County Registrar.
