Finance Updates

Current Finance Reporting

Staff are continuing to clean the financial information and are providing updated information to the auditors to ensure an accurate and complete draft audit report.

Contract for Enterprise Resource Planning – ERP, 2022

Staff met with the Tyler Project Management team Wednesday April 27 for a Scope Alignment discussion. The District administration team answered Tyler project management team's questions and the Tyler team provided information regarding the next steps in the development and implementation of the Tyler Incode system. Within the next few months, the Tyler team will begin assigning project managers for the beginning phase of the project, starting with the Chart of Accounts training and development. This initial exercise is critical to setting up a comprehensive and consistent general ledger.

Recruitment

The District is recruiting for both an Accountant and an Accounting Manager and has secured the services of Robert Half to assist in our search for the perfect candidate to fill our vacancy! We continue to receive applications through Indeed and the District website.

Utility Billing -Water Shut Off Notifications

The District has enrolled in the California Low Income Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) that provides financial assistance to low-income residents to help manage their residential water utility costs. The federal funds are administered by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and the California Department of Community Services and Development (CSD). LIHWAP is a customer-based program where qualified, low-income households can apply to the RMCSD to receive a one-time credit (up to \$2,000) on their water or wastewater bill. The District will administer this program locally and is required to provide customer outreach, intake, eligibility verification and identification of the LIHWAP credit amount. Because the District has not participated in low-income programs in the past, the creation of the eligibility program will require significant staff time to develop and implement, with Board approval. More information will be forthcoming in the May Board meeting.

Prop 218

To date, the District has only received 70 protest letters in response to the April mailing of the Prop 218 rate increases, however many of these have been from multiple residents with the same address. All Prop 218 protest letters must be received either in person or via mail no later than June 1, 2022. The District anticipates a large number of protest letters from the public but would like to remind residents that only ONE protest letter per property can be counted towards the total protest count.

If the District residents submit the required amount of protest letters to prevent the Prop 218 increases from becoming effective July 1, 2022, the District will use the current years' rates for the FY 2022-23.
